What we are doing as a school:

- We are asking the children to wash their hands often with soap and water.
- We have supplied every class room with a sanitiser gel and tissues.
- Always carry tissues with you and use them to catch your cough or sneeze. Then bin the tissue and wash your hands, or use the sanitiser gel.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Do not share items that come into contact with your mouth such as cups and bottles
- If a child is feeling unwell in school, we will be taken their temperature and phoning home if needed.
